Environmental impact assessment topics

The draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) includes a range of detailed technical studies in accordance with the EIS Guidelines set by the Environment Minister. You can read, review, and provide a submission on these studies, which are outlined in the draft EIS.



Heritage

Potential impacts associated with the project on Aboriginal and historic (non-Aboriginal) heritage were considered. The assessment was informed by desktop assessments alongside engagement with First Nations knowledge holders and stakeholders.

Key findings

- The proposed flight paths would fly over a number of culturally significant sites and places. However, in many cases, flight paths from existing airports already traverse the airspace above these sites and places.
- In general, WSI aircraft would be at a height and distance from these sites and places that any potential impact from aircraft would be minimal.
- Aircraft overflight and noise intrusion could significantly impact the Aboriginal cultural values of Bents Basin and the Shaw's Creek-Yellomundee Aboriginal Place.
- Options will be explored during the detailed design phase to reduce impacts to these and other culturally significant sites, where safe and feasible to do so.
